to improve the overall health of the communities we serve. In a recent survey of employees across our Pipeline Health organization, employees told us that the work they do is meaningful to them. Survey respondents gave this statement an average score of 4.6 on a scale of 1-5, with 5 being "strongly agree."

Each of our Pipeline hospitals is proud to hold a number of awards and accreditations for critical services. Working together, our Los Angeles hospitals have created a successful Patient Hub – a transfer center that moves eligible patients from other hospitals to available beds in our hospitals for quality care.

Serving the Underserved

Our commitment to serving the underserved is demonstrated throughout the year. For example, in 2022, our five hospitals wrote off a total of \$110,618,623 in charges to charity care.

U.S. Census data for individuals living within a five-mile radius of our hospitals describe a racially and ethnically diverse population with low socio-economic status.

Surrounding Coast Plaza Hospital (Norwalk):

- 52.25% of the population is non-White
- 51.2% of households earn \$74,999 or less annually

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Surrounding Community Hospital of Huntington Park:

- 61.2% of the population is non-White
- 17.4% of households earn \$15,000 or less annually
- 72.6% of households earn \$74,999 or less annually

Surrounding East Los Angeles Doctors Hospital:

- 57.4% of the population is non-White
- 14.7% of households earn \$15,000 or less annually
- 67% of households earn \$74,999 or less annually

Surrounding Memorial Hospital of Gardena:

- 70.6% of the population is non-White
- 11.3% of households earn \$15,000 or less annually
- 59% of households earn \$74,999 or less annually

Surrounding White Rock Medical Center:

- 59% of the population is non-White
- 48.5% of area residents earn less than \$50,000 annually
